Dear Resident/ Occupier,

[Notice of Upcoming Highway Works – Ely Road, Milton]
Highway maintenance works are due to take place in your area.

We are writing to let you know about upcoming road resurfacing works affecting Ely Road, Milton, between the Tesco roundabout and the junction with the A10. These works form part of the Council's Capital Maintenance Programme for 2026/27.

Project details

- **Location:** Ely Road, Milton, between the Tesco roundabout and the A10 junction
- **Start date:** Monday 10 August 2026 (anticipated)
- **Times:** 20:00 – 06:00 (overnight)
- **End date:** Tuesday 1 September 2026 (anticipated)
- **Duration:** 3 weeks (anticipated)
- **Traffic management:** Full Road closure with signed diversion route

How does this affect you?

- A signed diversion route will be in place for traffic travelling in both directions for the duration of the closure. The main diversion route will be via Milton Bypass, Butt Lane (C206), Access Road to Milton Road Park & Ride, Milton Road Roundabout, Cambridge Road and High Street (or the reverse, depending on your direction of travel).
- A secondary diversion route will be available via Humphries Way, connecting to the main diversion route described above (or the reverse, depending on your direction of travel).
- Please follow the on-street diversion signs and allow extra time for your journeys. A map of the diversion route is enclosed with this letter.
- This road is also used by Stagecoach East bus services (Route 2). Bus routes will be diverted for the duration of the works, and we are liaising with Stagecoach to confirm revised routes and stops. Please check with Stagecoach for the latest timetable information before you travel.
- If you live or work inside the closure, you can ask to pass through. Traffic management staff will assist you where possible.
- We ask that no vehicles are left on the carriageway or footway during the works.
- Due to the nature of the works, there will be some noise. We aim to complete the noisiest activities as early in the shift as possible, and before midnight each night where we can, to minimise disruption to residents during the later hours of the night. This might not always be possible. We appreciate your patience.



We will do our best to keep to schedule but unforeseen factors, such as weather, may cause delays. If major changes occur, we will update you accordingly. For latest updates please see our website via the QR code below.
